REVENUE CAR LOADINGS

FOR

WEEK ENDED NOVEMBER 7, 1925

There was very little change in car loadings in the eastern division last week compared with the previous week's beyond a decrease of 950 cars of coal and an increase in miscellaneous freight of 1,297 cars but the better weather in the western division stimulated grain loadings which showed an increase of 3,187 cars. Merchandise increased 531 cars and the total loadings were greater by 3,232 which with an increase of 561 cars in the eastern division made the increase for Canada 3,793 cars.

The total loading of 77,370 cars is the high record for this year and besides being 7,948 cars above the corresponding week in 1924 was 2,769 cars greater than the 1924 peak.
