REVENUE CAR LOADINGS FOR

WEEK ENDED JULY 4TH, 1925.

The affect of the national holiday on July 1st is apparent in the car loadings for last week, the total showing a decrease from the previous week of 5,390 cars. The decrease in the eastern division was 3,522 cars and in the western division, 1,868 cars. Merchandise showed the largest decrease, viz. 1,686 cars, which is generally the case. Very few merchandise cars are loaded on holidays and the regular cars, the next day, more or less take care of the merchandise received.

Compared with the corresponding week in 1924 grain was lighter by 1,638 cars and coal was down 3,073 cars. Gains were recorded in miscellaneous freight of 1,498 cars and in other forest products of 618 cars.
