## REVENUE CAR LOADINGS

FOR

## WEEK ENDED OCTOBER 2ND, 1926

Car loadings last week reached a new high record for the year amounting to $77,24 \theta$ cars, which has been exceeded only twice since 1923 when these reports were started, viz. for the week ended November 3, 1925 with 77,370 cars and for the week onded November 21 with 78,635 cars. The grain was still slow in moving being 3, 42, cars under the loadings for the corresponding week in 1825 and also 654 oars less than the immediately previous week this year. Miscellaneous freight bhowed an increase over last year's loadings of 1,228 cars, merchandise an increase of 1,756 cars, coal an inorease of 1,971 cars and other forest products an inorease of 572 oars. Other commodities showed smaller increases except pulpwood which was lighter by 213 cars, the total loadings being heavier by 2,377 cars.
