FOR
WEEK ENDED OCTOBER 30th, 1926

Car loadings for the week ended October 30 amounted to 84,081 cars, this being the third week to exceed 80,000 cars. Grain loading increased 911 cars over the previous week, but was 4,445 cars heavier than in 1925; the weather was very unfavourable in the west during October last year. Live stock showed an increase of 339 cars over the previous week's loadings, coal was slightly lighter, all the forest products showed small increases and miscellaneous freight was heavier by 168 cars but merchandise and coal showed small decreases.

Compared with the corresponding week in 1925 the total increase was 10,572 cars. Besides the large increase in grain, merchandise was heavier by 1,345 cars, miscellaneous freight by 2,240 cars, coal by 402 cars, lumber by 410 cars, pulpwood by 436 cars and ore was heavier by 777 cars.
