REVENUE CAR LOADINGS  
FOR  
WEEK ENDED OCTOBER 9TH, 1926

Car loadings last week showed an increase over the previous week of 788 cars, practically all of this being made in the eastern division. Grain increased by 1,118 cars being the heaviest so far this year, merchandise was heavier by 425 cars and pulp and paper by 275 cars. Decreases were shown by live stock, coke, lumber, other forest products and miscellaneous freight.

Compared with the corresponding week in 1925 total loadings were heavier by 4,687 cars. Grain loading was relatively light during October last year, the increase this year being 903 cars. Coal increased by 1,257 cars and merchandise by 2,638 cars. Live stock was lighter by 1,208 cars and lumber was lighter by 171 cars, but all other commodities showed increases.
