REVENUE CAR LOADINGS
FOR
WEEK ENDED NOVEMBER 6TH, 1926

For the fourth consecutive week car loadings have been heavier than in any week in previous years. Total loadings for the week ended November 6 were 83,812 cars which was 269 cars less than for the previous week. Grain loading in the western division increased by 2,258 cars but fell off 358 cars in the eastern division. The big drop was in miscellaneous freight which was lighter by 1,199 cars in the eastern division and 300 cars in the western division. Live stock fell off 219 cars, lumber was lighter by 328 cars and pulpwood by 406 cars.

The increase of 3,238 cars of grain over last year's loadings was all in the western division. Coal showed an increase of 1,563 cars in the east and merchandise was heavier by 1,274 cars, but miscellaneous freight was lighter by 398 cars, total loadings showing an increase of 6,482 cars.
