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## REVENUE CAR LOADINGS <br> FOF

## WEEK ENDED APRIL 17 TH, 1926

Car loadings for the week ended April 17 aggregated 56,543 Cars which was an increase over the previous week's loadings of 2,932 cars and over the corresponding week in 1925 of 6,929 cars.

The embargo on grain for Fort William-Port Arthur which had been in effect since January was removed on April 12 and grain showed an increased loading of 1,706 cars in the west and 197 cars in the eastern division. Coal loading was heavier in the eastern division by 880 cars but fell off 579 cirs in the west. All of the forest products group showed declines from the previous week, meiohanalse held its own in the west and increased 438 cars in the east and miscellaneous freight showed increases in both divisions.
