WEEK ENDED MAY 29TH, 1926

Car loadings for the week ended May 29th showed the effect of the national holiday, May 24, and declined by 6,277 cars or 10 per cent compared with the previous week. The big decreases were in grain 2,738 cars, merchandise 1,919 cars and miscellaneous freight 1,934 cars.

Compared with the corresponding week in 1925 which also included the holiday, loadings were heavier by 11,471 cars or 25 per cent. Grain showed an increase of 3,688 cars, coal 4,581 cars, merchandise 1,124 cars and miscellaneous freight a gain of 2,121 cars.
