## REVENUE CAR LOADINGS <br> FOR

WEEK ENDED AUMUST 7TH, 1926
Car loadings for the week ended August 7 th were 4,789 cars less than the previous week, the decrease in the eastern division being 3,948 cars and in the western division 841 cars; August 2nd. Was a civic holiday in many municipalities and affected the loading. Compared with the corresponding week in 1925 total loadings were heavier by 8,334 cars. The strikes in 1925 were chiefly reaponsible for the increase of 4,563 cars of coal, but merchandise showed an increase of 2,164 cars and miscellaneous freight an increase of 1,504 cars. Other commodities showed minor increases and decreases.
