WEEK ENDING JANUARY 22ND, 1927

Car loadings for the week ended January 22nd showed a decrease of 1,170 cars. This was due to the severe cold weather in the west. The eastern division showed an increase of 1,701 cars, whereas the western division showed a decrease of 2,871 cars. The largest decrease was in grain and grain products which fell off 3,497 cars. There was an increase in coal loading of 1,669 cars, in pulpwood of 442 cars and in merchandise of 658 cars.

Compared with the same period in 1926 total loadings were heavier by 3,762 cars.
