Car loadings for the week ended October 1 were heavier than for the previous week by 7,572 cars, the big increase being in grain which was heavier by 6,903 cars. Coal increased by, 614 cars and merchandise by 423 cars.

Grain loading was heavier than for the corresponding week last year by 3,316 cars, merchandise increased by $1,049 \mathrm{cars}$ and miscellaneous freight by 1,473 cars, but coal was lighter by 417 cars and pulpwood decreased by 192 cars, the total loadings being heavier by 5,100 cars.
