FOR
WEEK ENDING OCTOBER 22, 1927
(42nd Week)

Car loadings for the week ended October 22 reached a new high record of 87,613 cars, the previous peak being 85,244 cars for the week ended October 16, 1926. The very fine weather throughout the week in the western division greatly accelerated grain loading, which almost doubled the previous week's loadings. The movement in the eastern division, largely from the Bay ports, lags somewhat, and was not affected so greatly. Miscellaneous freight also showed the substantial increase of 1,265 cars and other forest products were heavier by 541 cars. Decreases were made by live stock, 298 cars; coal, 552 cars; coke, 338 cars; lumber, 188 cars; pulpwood, 125 cars; and pulp and paper, 300 cars, the total being 10,466 cars heavier than for the previous week.

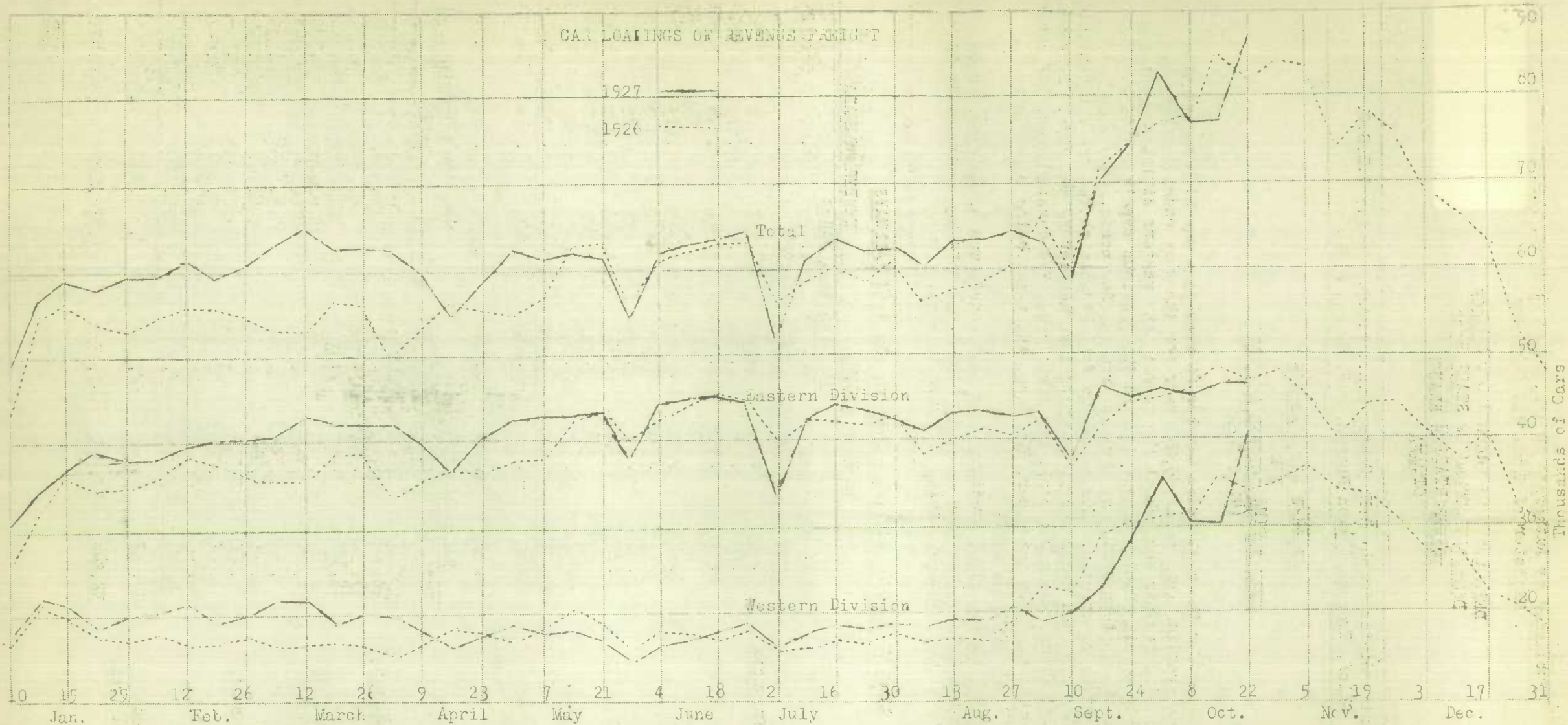
The increase in the total loadings over last year's was 5,582 cars, grain increasing by 4,454 cars, miscellaneous freight by 1,317 cars and merchandise by 435 cars, the only large decrease being 707 cars in coal.
