REVENUE CAR LOADINGS
 FOR
 WEEK ENDING MARCH 19TH, 1927
 (11th Week)

The severe snow storm in the western provinces last week affected the car loadings, which were less than for the previous week by 2,448 cars in the western division and by 483 cars in the eastern division. The grain in the west fell off by 1,710 cars and pulpwood in the eastern division was lighter by 921 cars.

Compared with loadings during the week ended March 20, 1926, the total was greater by 5,168 cars, coal accounting for 2,986 cars, grain for 1,775 cars and pulpwood for 1,501 cars of the increase.
