REVENUE CAR LOADINGS  
FOR  
WEEK ENDING APRIL 16TH, 1927  
(15th Week)

The holiday on Good Friday was responsible for the large decrease in car loadings for the week ended April 16, which were lower than the previous week by 5,257 cars. There were decreases in all commodities except pulp and paper and ore, which showed increases of 72 and 121 cars respectively. The largest decreases were in merchandise, which was lower by 1,805 cars, grain by 1,129 cars, miscellaneous freight by 696 cars, pulpwood by 644 cars and live stock by 583 cars.

Compared with the corresponding week in 1926, loadings were lighter by 1,929 cars.
