Car loadings for the week ended April 30 amounted to 62,232 cars, which was an increase of 3,636 over the previous week's loading. This improvement was more or less seasonal assisted by better weather. Navigation on the upper lakes which cpened Aoril 16 al so influenced the movement of grain, which increased by 1,585 cars. Tre other large gain mas 1,364 cars in miscellaneous freight.

Compared rith the corresponding week in 1925 the increase was 6,359 ears. Navigation had not opened last year and the grain loading was 2,807 cars under this year's. Coal loading was al so heavier this year by 2,146 cars, merchandise słowed an increase of 1,202 cars and miscellaneous freight an increase of 1,159 cars.
