> REVENUE CAR LOADINGS FOR WEEK ENDING JULY 16th, 1927 (28th Week)

Car loadings for the week ended July 16 amounted to 63,469 cars, which was an increase over the previous week's loading of 1,920 cars.

Grain increased by 268 cars, lumber by 216 cars, other forest products by 550 cars, ore by 596 cars and miscellaneous freight by 837 cars. Merchandise was lighter by 868 cars and other commodities showed only small changes. Compared with loadings of last year the increase was 3,211 cars, grain accounting for 997 cars of the increase, coal for 1,413 cars and miscellaneous freight for 984 cars. Decreases were made by live stock, 'pulpwood and ore.
