## REVENUE CAR LOADINGS FOR <br> THETK ENDING JULY 16th, 1927 <br> (28th Week)

Car loadings for the week ended July 16 amounted to 63,469 cars, which mas an increase over the previous week's loading of 1,920 cars.

Grain increased by 268 cars, lumber by 216 cars, other forost products by 550 cars, ore by 596 cers and miscelleneous freight by 837 cars. Merchendise was lighter by 868 cars and other commodities showed only small changes. Compared with loadings of last year the increase mas 3,211 cars, grain accounting for 997 cars of the increasc, coal for 1,413 cars and miscellancous freight for 984 cars. Decreases wero made by live stock, pulprood and ore.
