REVENUE CAR LOADINGS FOR WEEK ENDING JULY 23rd, 1927 (29th Week)

Car loadings for the week ended July 23 showed a decrease from the previous week's of 1,029 cars, grain declining by 1,424 cars, ore by 515 cars, and miscellaneous freight by 330 cars. Merchandise increased by 1,002 cars and other commodities showed minor changes.

Compared with loadings of the corresponding week last year total loadings were heavier by 3,093 cars, marchandise being heavier by 1,302 cars, miscellaneous freight increasing by 950 cars, grain by 571 cars, coal by 465 cars and lumber by 373 cars. Decreases were shown by live stock, pulpwood, other forest products and ore.
