# REVENUE CAR LOADINGS <br> WEEK ENDING JULY $97 \mathrm{H}, 1227$ <br> (2 7th Week) 

Car loadings for the week ended July 9 showed considerable improvement over the previous week's which were affected by the two holidays. The total increase amounted to 10,008 cars of which 4,248 cars were merchandise and 3.576 cars mere miscellaneous freight. There were smaller increases in all the other commodities except other forest products and ore which showed decreases of 394 and 408 cars, respectively.

Compared with the same period last year loadings were heavier by 2,229 cars; coal accounting for 1,026 cars of this, merchandise for 809 cars, miscellaneous freight for 789 cars, grain for 553 cars and live stock for 388 cars.
