Car loadings for the week ended June 23 amounted to 67,803 cars which was a decline from the previous week's of 572 cars, all of which was in the western division where grain decreased by 613 cars and miscellaneous freight by 1,069 cars.

Compared with last year's loadings for the corresponding week the increase was 3,464 cars, grain being heavier by 1,656 cars, miscellaneous freight by 1,406 cars, merchandise by 665 cars and ore by 200 cars.
