The National heliday on Monday, July 2, affected the car loadings for the week ended July 7, especially in the eastern division, where the decrease from the previous week's loadings amounted to 4,858 cars and from the loadings for the same week last year of 2,541 cars. In the western division the decrease from the previous week's loadings was 3,755 cars, but, from heavier grain, coal, pulpwood and other forest products loading, the total was heavier than for the same week in 1927 by 1,279 cars.
