Car loadings for the week ended July 14 exceeded those of the previous week, which contained a holiday, by 8,887 cars and were heavier than for the corresponding week in 1927 by 5,602 cars. Grain loading was heavier than in 1927 by 1,148 cars, pulpwood by 1,175 cars, merchandise by 1,368 cars and miscellaneous freight by 1,895 cars. The increase over 1927 in the cumulative total to July 14 of 100,147 cars has been all in the eastern division where grain increased by 49,578 cars, merchandise by 17,386 cars, miscellaneous freight by 19,431 cars and the total by 108,372 cars.
