Car loadings for the week ended October 13 showed an increase over the previous week's of 2,470 cars. Grain decreased by 386 cars and ore was lighter by 477 cars, but miscellaneous freight increased by 1,431 cars, coal by 1,337 cars, live stock by 290 cars and merchandise by 203 cars. Compared with loadings in 1927 for the same week, the increase was 14,949 cars, the western division accounting for 9,178 cars of this increase and the eastern division for 5,771 cars. Grain was heavier by 9,098 cars, miscellaneous freight by 3,801 cars, pulpwood by 1,040 cars and merchandise by 763 cars.
