
## CAR LOADINGS

Car leadings for the week ended November 25 amounted to 52,316 as against 53,164 cars the previous week and 55,394 cars for the same week last year.

Merchandise was lighter than last year by 1,850 cars, miscellaneous freight by 883 cars, grain by 552 cars, lumber by 470 cars, pulp and paper by 421 cars and other forest products by 481 cars. Coal increased by 1,423 cars, pulpwood by 195 cars and live stock by 105 cars.

The decrease in merchandise of 118 cars from the previous week's loadings was seasonal and was less than normal; consequently the index number increased to 88.68 from 87.50 for the previous week.

Total loadings in the eastern division amounted to 31,587 which was a decrease from the previous week of 869 cars and the index number dropped from 77.91 to 77.22. In the western division loadings increased from 20,708 cars for the previous week to 20,729 and as normally there is a decrease at this time of the year, the index number rose from 66.21 to 69.42. Western live stock amounted to 1,310 cars, or 154 cars more than during the previous week. Coke increased by 35 cars and other forest products increased from 780 to 1,017 cars. Total loadings for both divisions were 1,094 cars less than for the previous week, but, when corrected for seasonal variation, the index number rose from 72.78 for the 47th week to 73.82 for last week. It has not recovered, however, from the drop from 78.91 for the 45th week and 79.95 for the 46th week.
