

MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS

OCTOBER - DECEMBER 1969

The motor vehicle traffic accidents referred to in this report are those occurring on public roads and streets, including boulevards and paths adjacent to the travelled portions of streets and highways. Non-traffic accidents are those occurring on private property or elsewhere not on a public way and are excluded from this report. The information contained in this series is based on police records. When only property damage is sustained in a traffic accident, any accident with a minimum of \$100 damage is reported by every province and territory.

For comparing yearly totals with traffic deaths reported in DBS "Vital Statistics", please see the explanation in the January-March 1969 Motor Vehicle Traffic Accidents report.

During the fourth quarter of 1969, motor vehicle traffic accidents in Canada numbered 155,909 of which 1,262 were fatal accidents, 32,279 were non-fatal injury accidents and 122,368 resulted in property damage only. The number of accidents reported for the fourth quarter of 1969 was less in Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Quebec and the Yukon and Northwest Territories and greater in the remaining provinces than the number reported for the same period in 1968. The value of property damage from all accidents (Quebec estimated), amounted to \$92.9 million.

Persons killed during the period totalled 1,484. Prince Edward Island, New Brunswick, Manitoba and Saskatchewan reported decreases in fatalities compared with the fourth quarter of 1968, with the Yukon and Northwest Territories remaining unchanged at 5. Persons injured in all provinces numbered 48,486 with all reporting authorities showing increases from the previous year, except Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Saskatchewan and the Yukon and Northwest Territories which reported decreases in the number of persons injured over the October-December 1968 period.
