# **MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS**

(Period January 1 to March 31, 1955.)

In the first quarter of 1955, 35,558 accidents were reported by nine provinces (excluding Quebec) and the Territories. Fatal accidents numbered 319, non-fatal 6,407 and property damage accidents were 28,832 in number. During the period 353 persons were killed and 9,053 injured.

Newfoundland, Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, and Ontario had fewer accidents in the first quarter of 1955 compared with the same period in 1954, but all other provinces showed an increase. Legislation, effective March 18,1955, raised the minimum reportable amount for property damage accidents in Prince Edward Island to \$100. The minimum was formerly \$50 except in Charlottetown where all accidents were reportable. The Ontario minimum was raised from \$50 to \$100 on April 6, 1954 and undoubtedly was a factor in the reduced total reported by Ontario for the first quarter of 1955.

The number of persons killed in the first three months of 1955 dropped in New Brunswick, (from 23 to 17), Manitoba (from 17 to 12) and British Columbia (from 27 to 26), but rose in all other provinces except Nova Scotia which was unchanged at 20 fatalities. Persons injured dropped in Newfoundland (from 85 to 79), Manitoba (from 518 to 452), Saskatchewan (from 422 to 342), Yukon - North West Territories (from 27 to 19).
