MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS

Motor vehicle traffic accidents reported for nine provinces (excluding Quebec) and the Yukon and Northwest Territories for October, November and December 1955, numbered 45,051 of which 517 were fatal accidents, 9,748 were non-fatal injury accidents, and 34,786 resulted in property damage only. During this period 585 persons were killed and 14,038 injured. Property damage resulting from accidents in eight provinces (excluding Quebec and Manitoba) totalled \$15.5 million. In the three-month period covered by this report, 184 drivers, 198 passengers, 188 pedestrians, and 15 bicyclists, motorcyclists and others were killed, while 4,642 drivers, 6,401 passengers, 2,434 pedestrians and 561 bicyclists, motorcyclists and others were injured.

The number of accidents occurring during the quarter increased in all provinces except Newfoundland, Prince Edward Island, New Brunswick and British Columbia, when compared with the same period in 1954. Nova Scotia accidents increased from 2,832 to 3,489 and in Ontario there were 19,384 compared with 17,548 for the same three months in 1954. The death toll was reduced in all provinces except New Brunswick and Saskatchewan while the number of fatalities in British Columbia was unchanged. The number of persons injured decreased in Prince Edward Island, New Brunswick, Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta.
