MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS

(For Period July 1 to September 30, 1956)

Motor vehicle traffic accidents reported for nine provinces, (excluding Quebec), and the Territories for July, August and September 1956, numbered 39,089 of which 626 were fatal accidents, 10,896 were non-fatal injury accidents, and 27,567 resulted in property damage only. During this period 721 persons were killed and 16,868 injured.

Newfoundland, New Brunswick, Ontario, Saskatchewan, Alberta, British Columbia and the Territories all showed increases in the number of accidents reported during the quarter as compared with the same period in 1955. Accidents in Ontario increased to 18,389 from 16,666 one year ago. The number of accidents occuring in Quebec is not available for the third quarter of 1956.

The number of persons killed during the quarter dropped in Newfoundland (from 16 to 10) in Prince Edward Island (from 8 to 7) in New Brunswick (from 40 to 37) and in Saskatchewan (from 48 to 38). All other reporting authorities showed increases in the number of fatalities. Nova Scotia was the only province to record a decrease in the number of persons injured as compared with the same period in 1955. The Territories remained unchanged at 37 persons injured during this quarter in 1956 and 1955.

The first nine months of 1956 resulted in a total of 140,198 accidents in Canada (including 33,840 reported by Quebec for the first half of 1956) compared with 99, 500 (excluding Quebec) in the same period in 1955. The number of persons killed was 1,583 as against 1,483 one year ago and persons injured increased to 39,266 from 35,736 in the January-September period of 1955.
