

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THE SYSTEM OF NATIONAL ACCOUNTS

In Canada, the National Accounts have been developed since the close of the Second World War in a series of publications relating to their constituent parts. These have now reached a stage of evolution where they can be termed a "System of National Accounts". For purposes of identification, all publications (containing tables of statistics, descriptions of conceptual frameworks, and descriptions of sources and methods) which make up this System will now carry the term "System of National Accounts" as a general title.

The System of National Accounts in Canada consists of several parts. The annual and quarterly Income and Expenditure Accounts (included with Catalogue Nos. carrying the prefix 13) were, historically speaking, the first set of statistics to be referred to with the title "National Accounts" (National Accounts, Income and Expenditure). The Balance of International Payments data, (Catalogue Nos. with prefix 67), in their more summary form, are also part of the System of National Accounts and they, in fact, pre-date the Income and Expenditure Accounts.

Greatly expanded structural detail on industries and on goods and services is portrayed in the Input-Output Tables of the System (Catalogue Nos. with prefix 15). The indexes of Real Domestic Product by Industry (included with Catalogue Nos. carrying the prefix 61) provide "constant dollar" measures of the contribution of each industry to gross domestic product at factor cost. Inputs and outputs are related in Productivity Studies (Catalogue Nos. with prefix 14).

Both the Input-Output Tables and Indexes of Real Domestic Product by Industry use the establishment as the primary unit of industrial production. Measures of financial transactions are provided by the Financial Flow Accounts (Catalogue Nos. with prefix 13). Types of lenders and financial instruments are the primary detail in these statistics, and the legal entity is the main unit of classification of transactors. Also, provision is made in the System for incorporation of balance sheet (wealth) estimates when such data are sufficiently developed.

The System of National Accounts provides an overall conceptually integrated framework in which the various parts can be considered as interrelated sub-systems. At present, direct comparisons amongst those parts which use the establishment as the basic unit and those which use the legal entity can be carried out only at highly aggregated levels of data. However, Statistics Canada is continuing research on enterprise-company-establishment relationships; it may eventually be feasible to reclassify the data which are on one basis (say the establishment basis) to correspond to the units employed on another (the company or the enterprise basis).

In its broad outline, the Canadian System of National Accounts bears a close relationship to the international standard as described in the United Nations publication, *A System of National Accounts* (Studies in Methods, Series F, No. 2, Rev. 3, Statistical Office, Department of Economic and Social Affairs, United Nations, New York, 1968).

LE SYSTÈME DE COMPTABILITÉ NATIONALE

Au Canada, les comptes nationaux ont fait l'objet depuis la fin de la Seconde Guerre mondiale de toute une série de publications portant sur leurs éléments constitutifs. Ils ont connu une telle évolution qu'on peut maintenant les qualifier de "Système de comptabilité nationale". Aux fins d'identification, toutes les publications qui font partie du système (elles contiennent des tableaux statistiques, l'explication des cadres théoriques et l'explication des sources et des méthodes) porteront désormais le titre général de "Système de comptabilité nationale".

Le système de comptabilité nationale du Canada se divise en plusieurs catégories de comptes. Les comptes annuels et trimestriels de revenu et de dépenses (publiés dans les bulletins dont le numéro de catalogue commence par 13) ont constitué le premier ensemble de statistiques à être connu sous le titre de "Comptes nationaux" (Comptes nationaux, revenus et dépenses). Les données sur la balance des paiements internationaux (numéros de catalogue commençant par 67) font également partie, sous leur forme sommaire, du système de comptabilité nationale; elles ont même existé avant les comptes de revenu et de dépenses.

Une nomenclature, sensiblement augmentée, d'industries et de biens et services figure dans les tableaux d'intrants et extrants (input-output) du système (numéro de catalogue commençant par 15). Les indices du produit intérieur réel par industrie (compris dans les publications dont les numéros de catalogue commencent par 61) mesurent, en "dollars constants", l'apport de chaque branche d'activité au produit intérieur brut au coût des facteurs. Un rapport est établi entre intrants et extrants dans les études de productivité (publications dont les numéros de catalogue commencent par 14).

L'établissement sert d'unité de base de la production industrielle tant dans les tableaux 'input-output' que dans les indices du produit intérieur réel. Les comptes de flux financiers (publications dont les numéros de catalogue commencent par 13) mesurent les opérations financières. Les catégories de prêteurs et d'instruments financiers forment les éléments de base de ces statistiques et la personne morale est le point de départ du classement des agents économiques. En outre, le système a été conçu de façon à pouvoir incorporer les comptes de bilans (qui prennent pour objet le patrimoine) lorsque les données s'y rapportant seront suffisamment développées.

Le système de comptabilité nationale constitue un ensemble conceptuellement intégré dans lequel les diverses catégories de comptes peuvent être considérées comme des sous-systèmes étroitement liés entre eux. Au stade actuel de développement, on ne peut faire de comparaison directe entre les éléments basés sur l'établissement et ceux qui sont basés sur l'entité légale que lorsque les données sont groupées dans des catégories très générales. Toutefois, Statistique Canada poursuit ses recherches sur les relations entre l'entreprise, la société et l'établissement. Il sera peut-être possible un jour de reclasser les données fondées, par exemple, sur l'établissement de manière à les faire correspondre aux données établies d'après la société ou l'entreprise.

Dans ses grandes lignes, le système de comptabilité nationale du Canada est étroitement relié à la norme internationale exposée dans la publication des Nations Unies - *Système de comptabilité nationale* (Études méthodologiques, série F, No 2, Rev. 3, Bureau de statistique, Département des affaires économiques et sociales, Nations Unies, New York, 1970).

For the period prior to 1971 the data are not available on a 1971 base. To obtain a continuous record on a 1971 base, the indexes on a 1961 base must be mechanically rebased to 1971 by multiplying by 100.0 and dividing by the 1971 index value on a 1961 base. TECHNICAL NOTE

This report presents measures of Real Domestic Product (RDP) by industry for the 1971 - 1974 period on a 1971 time and weight base. It should also be noted that the 1970 Standard Industrial Classification is used in this publication. Underlying concepts and general methodology remain unchanged.

1971 Industry Weights

The 1971 industry weights introduced in this report are based on preliminary estimates of the industrial distribution of Gross Domestic Product for the year 1971. In deriving the industry weights, the latest available data from Statistics Canada censuses and annual surveys were used. It was also necessary to exploit sources such as company annual reports and taxation records, as well as operating ratios from other sources. The 1971 GDP distributions can be finalized only after detailed reconciliation of all components of the System of National Accounts following the completion of the 1971 Input-Output table. It is expected, however, that the industrial distribution will not be substantially changed, particularly for the higher aggregates.

As shown by the table below, service-producing industries increased their share of total GDP in 1971 as compared with 1961. This represents a continuation of a trend apparent between 1949 to 1961, the two previous weight base periods.

Annual Measures

Annual measures as distinct from monthly projectors have been calculated on a 1971 base for only the few industries for which annual survey data beyond 1972 were available. Additional annual levels will be incorporated into the monthly record at the time of the next annual publication. At that time additional industrial detail may be provided as well.

Monthly Measures

The monthly measures have been modified to reflect changes in available data. Average 1971 unit values were used to combine quantities of commodity outputs where these form the basis of projection. Monthly employment series used in the computation of the output measures have been mechanically rebased to 1971 in most instances, and will be revised later when they are fully converted to the 1970 S.I.C. and a 1971 base. Where deflated value series are used, price

NOTE TECHNIQUE

Cette publication présente des mesures du produit intérieur réel (P.I.R.) par industrie pour la période 1971 - 1974. Les bases de référence et de pondération de ces mesures sont celles de 1971. Il est à noter également que la Classification des activités économiques de 1970 est utilisée dans cette publication. Les concepts sous-jacents et la méthodologie générale n'ont pas changé.

Pondérations 1971 de l'industrie

Les pondérations 1971 de l'industrie présentées ici sont basées sur des estimations provisoires de la répartition industrielle du produit intérieur brut pour l'année 1971. Les dernières données disponibles des recensements et des enquêtes annuelles de Statistique Canada ont été utilisées pour établir ces pondérations. On s'est également servi d'autres données, comme les déclarations annuelles et les dossiers fiscaux des entreprises, et aussi des ratios d'exploitation provenant d'autres sources. Les répartitions du P.I.B. de 1971 ne pourront être calculées que lorsqu'on aura terminé le rapprochement détaillé de tous les éléments du système des comptes nationaux, une fois le tableau des entrées sorties de 1971 terminé. On s'attend, cependant, à ce que la répartition industrielle et en particulier les principaux agrégats, ne subissent pas de changements importants.

Comme l'indique le tableau ci-dessous, comparativement à 1961, les industries de services tiennent une place plus importante dans le P.I.B. total. Cette augmentation est la suite de la tendance apparue entre 1949 et 1961, les deux dernières années à servir de base aux pondérations.

Mesures annuelles

Des mesures annuelles différentes des projections mensuelles n'ont été calculées sur la base 1971 = 100 que pour les quelques industries dont les données annuelles d'enquête avant 1972 étaient encore disponibles. Des niveaux annuels supplémentaires seront ajoutés aux données mensuelles dans le prochain numéro annuel de cette publication qui présentera peut-être également d'autres données sur les industries.

Mesures mensuelles

Les mesures mensuelles ont été modifiées de façon à prendre en compte les changements propres aux données disponibles. Des valeurs unitaires moyennes de 1971 ont été utilisées pour combiner les quantités produites lorsque ces dernières servaient de base aux projections. La plupart des séries mensuelles sur l'emploi utilisées dans le calcul des mesures de sorties ont été converties arithmétiquement sur l'année de base 1971 et seront révisées lorsque toutes ces séries auront été alignées sur la C.A.É. de 1970.

indexes used in the construction of deflators have been simply re-expressed on a 1971 time base.

As before the monthly measures have been level adjusted on the basis of the historical relationship between monthly projectors and annual measures. The seasonal adjustment factors have been revised for the 1971 - 1974 period.

Linking RDP on a 1971 base with RDP on a 1961 base

Subject to rounding errors, a linked series can be calculated between the 1961- and 1971-based RDP series which are identical under the 1960 and 1970 S.I.C.'s using the index values for 1971. For a 1971-based series, the 1961-based series should be multiplied by 100.0 and divided by the index value for 1971 for the series on the 1961 base. For a continuous series on a 1961 base, the 1971-based series should be multiplied by the index value for 1971 for the series on a 1961 base and divided by 100.0.

A table providing linkages between the 1961- and 1971-based series will be prepared and made available at a later date. The availability of this table will be announced in the *Statistics Canada Daily* and in the monthly publication (catalogue 61-005).



Comparison of the 1961 and 1971 Based Series

The table below provides a comparison of year-to-year changes in a number of aggregate measures. For Real Domestic Product the growth rates are 3.8% for 1974, 6.3% for 1973 and 5.0% for 1972. Growth has been lowered for 1972 and 1973 and raised slightly for 1974.

As can be seen from the table, Real Domestic Product excluding agriculture has been altered in roughly the same pattern as Real Domestic Product. Goods-producing industries have changed only in 1973 while service-producing industries have changed in all three years.

The monthly seasonal movements have been altered as a result of revisions to seasonal factors, modification of some projectors, and the introduction of new weights. Seasonally adjusted Real Domestic Product is now smoother than in the previously published data.

The chart on page X provides a comparison of seasonally adjusted monthly RDP on the 1961 and 1971 bases.

Le tableau ci-dessous sert à comparer les changements annuels d'un certain nombre d'agrégats. Le taux de croissance du produit intérieur réel était de 3.8 % en 1974, 6.3 % en 1973 et 5.0 % en 1972. Il a été réduit pour 1972 et 1973 et légèrement augmenté pour 1974.

Comme le tableau l'indique, le produit intérieur réel sans l'agriculture a été modifié en gros de la même façon que le produit intérieur réel. Les séries relatives aux industries de biens n'ont été modifiées que pour 1973, tandis que celles des industries de services l'ont été pour les trois années observées.

Les variations mensuelles désaisonnalisées ont changées à la suite de la révision des facteurs saisonniers, de la modification de certaines bases de projection et de l'introduction de nouvelles pondérations. La courbe du produit intérieur réel après désaisonnalisation est maintenant plus lisse.

Le graphique, page X, permet de comparer le P.I.R. mensuel après désaisonnalisation basé sur les séries 1961 = 100 et sur celles dont l'année référence est 1971.
