## PRICE MOVMENTS, MARCH, 1949 (PRSLIMINARY)

COST OF LIVING: The Dominion Bureau Of Statistiss costormiving index fall from 159.5 to 159.2 between February 1 and March 1. 1949. As in the preceding month. declines in foods outwelghed scattered increases in several other budeg groups. Price reductions for shortaning products, meats, butter and eggs Were malnly responsible for the frod index mowng down from 200.4 to 199. 1. There wexe moderate offsetting seasonal increases in a few vegetablea. The clothing inm dex rose from 181.8 to 182.7 , and homefurnishings and serpices gained fractionally from 167.8 to 167:9. Tuel and light also moved up a small anount from 130.8 to 131. O. The miscellaneous items index held at 128.1, and the rent index continues nominally at 121.7 until returns from the March survey are complete.

The March, 1949 costof-11ving index was 57.9 per cent above the Ausust. 19391 evel,

Further declines in commodity markets carried the industrial material price index from 159.2 for the week ending Febmary 25 to 156 . 0 for the week ending March 25. Steers, hogs and oats were higher, but lower auotations were recorded for lumier, cottonseed 011. rosin and lead. The index for Canadian Fam Products advanced from 145. 1 to 145.4 In the same perioa, as increases in livestock and eges outwelghed declincs in potatoes, corm, peas, hides, poultry and wool. Howevar, the averase level of this index for March was lower than the February average.
