

PRICE INDEX NUMBERS OF COMMODITIES AND SERVICES USED BY FARMERS


AUGUST, 1954 (1935-39 = 100)

The All Canada composite price index for commodities and services used by farmers, inclusive of farm living costs, rose 0.2 per cent from 224.5 in April to 225.0 in August. The August 1954 index stands at 1.4 per cent below the August index of a year ago. Exclusive of living costs, the All Canada composite index advanced 0.3 per cent to 238.7 between April and August but showed a decrease of 2.0 per cent from the comparable figure a year ago.

Farm wage rates, although registering a moderate seasonal advance, remained below August 1953 levels. The All Canada index, moved up 2.8 per cent to 463.2 between April and August as the eastern wage-rate series rose 3.5 per cent to 433.8 and the western series 1.9 per cent to 505.1.

Farm operating equipment and materials moved down 1.1 per cent, from 204.1 in April to 201.9 in August. Sub-groups contributing to the decline were: binder twine which dropped 20.5 per cent; feed, 1.6 per cent; hardware, 1.4 per cent; and gasoline, oil and grease, 0.7 per cent. Seed registered an advance of 3.5 per cent, entirely due to higher quotations in the western Canada series. Small percentage increases occurred for farm machinery and building materials while compounded fertilizer remained steady at 182.7.

Narrow fluctuations were observed among group price indexes of farm family living costs. The All Canada index rose 0.1 per cent between April and August to 204.5, 0.2 per cent below the August, 1953 level of 204.9. Increases for food and health maintenance offset recessions for fuel, household equipment and clothing. An index for miscellaneous items was unchanged at 124.6. Diverse tendencies in household equipment and fuel groups were reflected in the regional composite indexes; the eastern series advanced 0.3 per cent to 202.1 while the western series registered no net change at 206.9.
