## PRICE INDEX NUMBERS OF COMMODITIES AND SERVICES USED BY FARMERS

JANUARY 1963 (1935-39 = 100)

The All-Canada Composite Price Index of Commodities and Services Used by Farmers decreased 0.8 per cent from 269.9 in August 1962 to 267.8 in January 1963, as a result of the seasonal decline in Farm Wages. The current index is 2.8 per cent above the January 1962 level of 260.6. The index, exclusive of Living Component, fell 1.7 per cent to 290.8 over the period August to January but is 2.6 per cent higher than a year ago.

The All-Canada Farm Wage Rate Index dropped 6.0 per cent from 602.9 in August to 567.0 in January. The Western series showed the usual seasonal decline dropping 15.9 per cent from 646.7 to 543.8 but the Eastern series reversed a long standing pattern for this period and increased 2.0 per cent from 572.1 to 583.4.

The preliminary All-Canada Property Tax and Interest Rate Index, for the three periods in 1962, was revised from 220.6 to 228.0 reflecting a change in the Eastern series from 223.6 to 234.5 and in the Western series from 218.0 to 222.4.

The All-Canada Price Index of Equipment and Materials Used by Farmers increased 0.7 per cent from 236.0 in August to 237.6 in January and moved up 1.7 per cent over the whole year. The major changes in sub-groups, between August 1962 and January 1963, were: Binder Twine up 8.6 per cent, Seed up 1.4 per cent, Farm Machinery up 1.0 per cent, and Gasoline, Oil and Grease down 0.6 per cent.

The All-Canada Farm Family Living Component rose 1.0 per cent from 231.0 in August to 233.2 in January, mainly as the result of increases in the Food and Health Maintenance components of 2.7 and 2.6 per cent respectively.


