PRICE INDEX NUMBERS OF COMMODITIES AND SERVICES USED BY FARMERS


AUGUST 1963 (1935-39 = 100)

The All-Canada Composite Index of Commodities and Services Used by Farmers increased 0.8 per cent from 273.9 in April to 276.0 in August. This represents a 2.3 per cent increase from the August 1962 index of 269.9. Exclusive of the Living Component, the index advanced 0.3 per cent to 299.7 from 298.8 between April and August and was 1.3 per cent above the index of 295.8 a year ago.

The All-Canada Wage Rate increased 1.7 per cent from 612.1 in April to 622.6 in August. This new high stands 3.3 per cent above the August 1962 level of 602.9. Over the April-August period the Eastern series showed an increase of 1.9 per cent while the Western series rose 1.5 per cent to indexes of 594.7 and 662.3 respectively.

The Farm Equipment and Materials index decreased 0.5 per cent to 237.0 in August from 238.3 in April when decreases occurred in the Seed and Feed indexes while increases occurred in the Building Materials, Gasoline, Oil and Grease, Compounded Fertilizer and Hardware indexes. The Farm Machinery and Binder Twine indexes remained unchanged.

The All-Canada Farm Family Living Component rose 1.6 per cent from 236.5 in April to 240.3 in August. This was 4.0 per cent above the August 1962 index of 231.0. Increases in the Food and Clothing components were mainly responsible for the upward movement of the index.
