PRICE INDEX NUMBERS OF COMMODITIES AND SERVICES USED BY FARMERS

JANUARY 1964 (1935-39 = 100)

The All-Canada Composite Price Index of Commodities and Services Used by Farmers declined 0.3 per cent from 277.3 in August 1963 to 276.5 in January 1964 as a result of the seasonal decrease in Farm Wage Rates in Western Canada which offset increases in the Equipment and Materials and the Farm Family Living components. The index remained 2.7 per cent above the January 1963 figure of 269.2. Exclusive of Living Component, the index decreased 0.8 per cent to 299.6 in January 1964 from 302.0 in August but was 2.2 per cent higher than the January index a year ago.

The Preliminary All-Canada Property Tax and Interest Rate index for 1963 was revised from 228.0 to 239.2 reflecting a change in the Eastern component from 234.5 to 249.3 and in the Western from 222.4 to 230.5.

Between August and January the All-Canada Farm Wage Rate index moved down 5.6 per cent from 622.6 in August to 587.8 in January of this year. Regionally, the Eastern index rose 1.9 per cent to 605.9 while the index for Western Canada dropped 15.1 per cent to 562.1.

The Equipment and Materials index advanced 2.3 per cent from 237.0 to 242.5. The majority of the sub-groups in this index showed increases: Binder Twine 22.0 per cent, Seed 7.3 per cent, Farm Machinery 2.4 per cent, Building Materials 1.3 per cent and Feed 1.1 per cent. The Compounded Fertilizer index moved down 3.1 per cent as prices eased in Eastern Canada.

The All-Canada Farm Family Living Component at 241.7 for January 1964 was 0.6 per cent above August 1963 and 3.6 per cent above the comparable index for 1963.


