Sales at retail of new passenger cars, trucks and buses renorted to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics for March, 1934, shom an increase of $103.3 \%$ in numbers and 102.9\% in values as compared with March, 1933. There was a total of 8,379 veinicles sold for $\$ 8,393.350$ in March, 4,231 for $\$ 4,171,781$ in February, and 4,122 for $\$ 4,135,497$ in March, 1933.

New passenger cars sold numbered 7,540 in harch, 3,636 in February and 3,747 in March, 1933. Their retall values amounted to $\$ 7,546,872$ in March, $\$ 3,596,023$ in February and $\$ 3,756,899$ in March, 1933.

There mere 839 trucks and buses sold in Warch, 595 in February and 375 in March, 1933, and they were valued at \$846,478, \$575,758 and \$379,598 respectivelyt

Theeo statistics have been compiled from reports of nineteen companles whose sales comprise over $90 \%$ of total Canadian sales. The retail value used the price paid wo. indi vidual purchase at the Canadian point of manufacture and includes sales anu excise taxes. charge for standard accessories, dealer's comission, etc. Freight charges from Canadian point of manufacture to point of delivery have been excluded. Duty is included in the retail value of imported cars.
