

## NAN WOTOR VHHCIE SATES IN CHNADA IN SEPTEMBER, 1934.

Salos at rotail of now passonger cars, trucks and buses raported to the Dorinion Buraqu of Statistics for Suptarabor, 193lt, show an incroasa of $14.5 \%$ in numbers and $17.5 \%$ in valuo as comparod with Soptambar, .933 . There was a total of 3.940 nuw vubiclos sold for $\$ 4,065,744$ in Suptorber, 5,192 for $\$ 5,311,715$ in dugust, and 3,441 for $\$ 3,461,491$ in Soptanber, 1933.

Nom pasaengar cars solc nuvborod 3,017 in Saptariber, 4,000 in August, and 2,722 in Soptunber last yuar, and tho rotail valuo of thoso vohiclus was $\$ 3,135,674$, $\$ 4,127,221$ and $\$ 2,785,022$ rospoctivuly。

Thora woru 923 trucks and busus sol: in Supturabor for 3930,070 as compared with 1,192 for $\$ 1,184,494$ in August and 719 for $\$ 673.469$ in Suptoribor last yoar.

Thuso statistics hava boun compilad fror roports of ninatuan coripanios whose Balus coripriso ovor $9 \in \%$ of total Canadian Ealus. The rotail valuo usad is tho prico poid by an individual purchasor at tho Canaisian point of wanufacture and includes salos and oxciso trax, chargo for standard accussorios, doniaris corission, otc. Fruight charges from Canadian point of manufacture to point of dolivery have $b$ an axcludac. Draty is incluclod in tho rotail valuo of importod caris.


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
