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## NEW NOTOR VEHICLE SALES II CANADA IN FSBRU4RY, 1935.

Retail sales of new passenger cars, trucks and buses in Canada in February, 1935, show an increase of 69.1 per cent in number and 71.5 per cent in value as compared with February, 193\%. There were 7,202 new vohicles sold for $17,23 \frac{1}{4}, 126$ in February, 3,463 for $\$ 3,543,152$ in January, and 4,258 for ${ }^{3} 4,219,063$ in February, 1934 .

New passenger cars numbered 5,968 in Mebruary, 2, 850 in January and 3,642 in February last year, with corrosponding rotail valucs of $45,992,255,32,863,881$ and $\$ 3,607,242$, respectively. There were 1,234 trucks and buses sold for $11,241,871$ in February, 613 for $\$ 679,271$ in January and 616 for 3611,821 in Pebruary, 1934 .

These figures are compiled by the Dominion Burcau of Statistics from returns submitted by nineteen companics in 1933, tronty-two companies in 193: and twentythree companies in 1935.

## NET MOTOR VEHICLE SALES BY PROVINCES - FEBRUARY

The provincial figures for sales of motor vehicles show marked advances in each province over the figures for the same month in 1934. The value of motor vehicles sold in February was 119.0 per cent greater in Manitoba and 104.6 per cent greater in Quebec than in February, 1934. The increase was 80.5 per cent in the Maritime Provinces, 65.5 per cent in Ontario, 62.2 per cent in Alberta, 56.8 per cent in British Columbia, and 47.3 per cent in Saskatchewan. The relatively greater number of vehicles sold in some provinces than in others must, of course, be borne in mind when the provincial figures are compared.
