SALES OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES IN CANADA, JANUARY-DECEMBER, 1946

Preliminary results show 114,479 new motor vehicles sold at retail in Canada during 1946, having a retail value of \$179,589,602. Distribution of new vehicles was higher in the final quarter of the year than in any of the three previous quarters, reversing the downward trend which was in evidence during the third quarter of the year.

Passenger cars retailed during 1946 numbered 73,052 and these had a retail value of \$109,932,039. The last two months of the year witnessed a sharp upswing in sales and volume was higher in these two months than in any earlier month of the vear.

Sales of new trucks and buses continued at a steady rate during the final quarter and total distribution for the year was 41,427 units valued at \$69,757,563.
