SAIES OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES IN CANADA, JANUARY-JUNE, 1947

There were 19,965 new motor vehicles retailed for \$34,557,484 in June, 1947. Passenger car sales continued to increase, while commercial vehicle sales showed a decline from May.

In the first half of this year 101,619 new vehicles were sold for \$175,539,616 as compared with 46,889 units retailed for \$70,452,343 in the same period of 1946. Passenger car sales numbered 69,528 with a retail value of \$117,258,137 in the January-to-June period, while 32,091 trucks and buses were sold for \$58,281,479.
