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SALES OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES IN CANADA, JULY, 1947

There were 20,145 new motor vehicles retailed for \$35,352,307 in July, 1947. Passenger car sales fell off only slightly, while commercial vehicle sales increased considerably over June.

Cumulative totals for the first seven months of 1947 show 121,764 new vehicles sold at retail for \$210,891,923. In the same sevenmenth period of 1946, sales numbered 62,489 and had a value of \$96,262,511. Passenger car sales in the January-to-July period of 1947 reached 84,148 units which had a total retail value of \$142,409,574, surpassing the volume of sales in the full year 1946 when 77,742 passenger cars were sold for \$120,325,496.
