## SALES OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES IN CANADA, AUGUST, 1947

There were 16,578 new motor vehicles retailed for $\$ 30,306,805$ in August, 1947. Both passenger car and commercial vehicle sales declined from the previous month, but remained well above 1946 totals for the same months.

Cumulative results for the first eight months of 1947 show 138,342 new vehicles sold for $241,198,728$. In the same eight-month period of last year 68,980 units retailed at $\$ 104,779,236$. Passenger car sales in the January-to-August pariod of 1947 reached 95,915 with a retail value of $\$ 163,531,626$. This number was more than double the 41,733 passenger cars sold for $\$ 59,490,140$ in the corresponding period of 1946 .
