SALES OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES IN CANADA

SEPTEMBER, 1947

New motor vehicles sold at retail in Canada during September numbered 22,596 and had a total selling value of \$42,210,153. After moving downward in August compared with July, sales mounted sharply in September when a new peak for the year was established. Sales were more than double those for September, 1946 when 10,154 new vehicles retailed for \$17,416,384.

In the first nine months of 1947, 160,938 new vehicles sold for \$283,408,881 compared with the 82,396 units valued at \$129,656,903 which were distributed in the January-to-September period of 1946. Passenger cars made up 70% of the total vehicles sold in the first nine months of this year, numbering 112,070 and having a retail value of \$193,198,279. Last year, to the end of September, 51,668 passenger cars sold for an amount of \$77,576,584.
