## SALES OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES IN CANADA

## JANUARY, 1948

Retail sales of new motor vehicles in Canada amounted to 13,668 units in January, 1948, and their value was \$25,734,072. The increase over January, 1947, when 12,973 vehicles sold for \$21,968,795, was 5% in number and 17% in retail value.

Fewer trucks and buses were sold in January this year than last, but the number of passenger car sales increased by almost 1,000-from 8,391 in January, 1947 to 9,324 in January, 1948.
