## SALES OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES IN CANADA <br> JANUARY, 1948

Retail sales of new motor vehicles in Canada amounted to 13,668 units in January, 1948, and their value was $\$ 25,734,072$. The in= crease over January, 1947, when 12,973 vehicles sold for $\$ 21,968,795$, was $5 \%$ in number and $17 \%$ in retail value.

Fewer trucks and buses were sold in January this year than last, but the number of passenger car saleswincreased by almost $1,000 \mathrm{~m}$ from 8,391 in January, 1947 to 9,324 in January, 1948.
