## SALES OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES IN CANADA MAY, 1948

Sales of new motor vehicles declined for the second consecutive month in May. Volume was slightly lower when compared with the preceding month and with the same month of 1947. New vehicle sales totalled 18,408 units for a retail value of \$35,998,962 in May this year and 19,105 units valued at \$33,467,905 in May, 1947.

Passenger car sales totalled 10,688 in May this year, while 12,678 were sold in the same month last year. The number of commercial units, 7,720 exceeded the 6,427 vehicles sold in the corresponding month a year ago.
