SALES OF NEW MOTOR VEHICLES IN CANADA JULY, 1948

After having established a new peak for June, sales of new motor vehicles for July, 1948 declined considerably in physical volume. Volume was also considerably lower when compared with the same month of 1947. New vehicles totalled 15,523 units for a retail value of \$31,007,126 in July this year and 20,696 units valued at \$36,340,691 in July, 1947.

Passenger car sales totalled 9,683 in July this year while 14,763 units were sold in the same month last year. The number of commercial units, 5,840, was exceeded by the 5,933 vehicles sold in the corresponding month a year ago.
