New motor vehicle sales in December 1950 numbered 29,309 units with a retail value of \$63,196,857, an increase of 32% in number and of 41% in value over December 1949. This brought the preliminary estimate of total sales of new passenger cars, trucks, and buses in 1950 to 427,340 vehicles valued at \$877,964,461, 49% in excess of the 1949 totals for both number and value.

Passenger cars accounted for 22,668 vehicle sales in December 1950, while 6,610 were trucks and 31 were buses. Percentage gains amounted to 36% for passenger cars, 19% for trucks, and 3% for buses. In the twelve months of 1950, 322,991 new passenger cars were sold for \$658,242,803, 60% above the 1949 sales in both number and value. Truck sales advanced 24% in number from 83,450 in 1949 to 103,694 in 1950, while 573 buses were sold in 1949 and 655 in 1950.

December 1950 sales of new motor vehicles in Manitoba and Saskatchewan dropped below the December 1949 level by 7% and 11% respectively. Alberta sales were up 12% in number, while increases in the other provinces ranged between 35% and 60%.

Financing of Motor Vehicle Sales

New Vehicles--Financing of new motor vehicle sales in December advanced 35% over December 1949 as compared with a 66% gain for the twelve months of 1950 over 1949. There were 9,257 new vehicles financed in

December 1950 for \$13,649,587. Cumulative figures for the twelve months of 1950 show 135,037 new vehicles financed for \$191,113,112, while corresponding figures for 1949 were 81,502 new vehicles with a financed value of \$115,511,459.

Passenger car financing showed a smaller gain in December than did commercial vehicle financing, a trend contrary to that for the year 1950. A gain of 30% was recorded for passenger car financing in December and one of 48% for commercial vehicles, while the increases for the twelve-month period of 1950 over 1949 amounted to 82% for passenger car and 35% for commercial vehicle financing.

There were wide variations among the different provinces in percentage changes between December 1949 and December 1950. Gains in number of new vehicles financed ranged from 5% to 12% in the western provinces. Quebec and the Atlantic Provinces reported increases of 36% and 28%, while in Ontario, new vehicles financed were 6% in excess of the December 1949 total. This trend was apparent in the case of both passenger cars and commercial vehicles.

Used Vehicles--A greater increase was reported in financing of used than of new vehicles. Used vehicles financed in December 1950 numbered 15,431 with a financed value of \$10,337,286, 50% in number and 47% in amount of financing above December 1949. Of the 15,431 units, 12,398 were passenger cars and 3,033 were commercial vehicles.

By provinces, the greatest increase in used car financing in December was in Saskatchewan where a gain of 118% was recorded. Manitoba came next with an increase of 104%. Ontario registered an increase of 22%, while in the other provinces, gains ranged between 58% and 81%. These trends followed generally those for the January-December period.

Cumulative figures for the twelve-month period show 228,293 used vehicles financed for \$151,242,420 in 1950, an increase of 51% in number and 46% in amount of financing over the twelve months of 1949. Used passenger car financing increased 51% in number, from 124,595 units in 1949 to 188,664 in 1950, while used commercial vehicles financed during the year numbered 39,629, 47% above the 1949 figure of 26,891.

Sales and Financing of New Motor Vehicles Compared

New motor vehicles financed in December 1950 formed 31.6% of total new vehicles sold as compared with 30.9% in December 1949. Passenger cars financed, however, were only 29.4% of sales (30.8% in December 1949), while commercial vehicles financed were 38.9% of sales (31.2% in December 1949).

For the twelve months of 1950, the proportion of new vehicle financing to sales was 31.6 as compared with 28.5 for 1949. Passenger car financing in the twelve months of 1950 amounted to 30.0% of sales and commercial vehicles to 36.6%, while corresponding figures for 1949 were 26.3% and 33.7%.



