Sales of New Motor Vehicles

Canadians bought more new motor vehicles in June than in any other month on record. The new peak which had been established in May was exceeded by a wide margin. June sales of 45,814 new vehicles with a retail value of \$93,475,586 far outnumbered the 27,829 units which sold for \$57,546,107 in June 1949, both number and value increasing about two-thirds.

Passenger cars accounted for 35,145 of the total vehicles sold and sales of these were 75% greater in number in June this year than a year ago. The number of trucks sold in June (10,534) showed a gain of 36% over June a year ago.

Sales of new buses numbered 135 in June this year and 57 in June a year ago. The June increase followed a succession of decreases reported in earlier months of 1950.

At mid-year, the cumulative sales of new vehicles totalled 213,906, up 55% over the 137,721 new vehicles sold in the first half of 1949. The six-month total of new passenger car sales, 164,662, was 77% above that for the same period of 1949. Truck sales were up only 11%, while sales of new buses declined from 375 to 307, or 18%.

Financing of Motor Vehicle Sales

The operations of finance companies have been very greatly affected by the marked increase in new vehicle sales. In fact, with higher proportions of car sales being financed this year, the percentage increases in financing of new vehicles are much higher than those for sales of new cars.

New Vehicles. - New vehicle sales financed numbered 13,770 units with a financed value of \$19,305,068, increases of 89% in number and 85% in amount of financing over June 1949 when 7,272 new vehicle sales were financed to the extent of \$10,454,896.

By far the largest gain was that for new passenger cars, the number of units financed increasing 129% over June last year. New passenger car sales financed in June numbered 10,054 units compared with 4,394 in June a year ago.

In the six-month period of 1950, 64,142 new vehicles with a financed value of \$88,627,813 were sold under conditional sales agreements with finance companies. The increase over last year, when 37,190 vehicle sales were financed for \$53,548,255, amounted to 73% in number and 66% in volume of financing. Passenger cars showed an increase of 105% over January-to-June 1949, while a gain of 19% in number of commercial vehicles financed was recorded.

Used Vehicles. - There were 25,459 used vehicles financed in June to the extent of \$16,175,714, an increase of 58% in number and 48% in amount of financing over June a year ago.

Passenger car sales financed numbered 21,361, a gain of 59% over June 1949, while commercial vehicle financing rose 53% to 4,098 vehicles.


During the first six months of 1950, 109,085 used vehicle sales were financed, 49% more than in the first half of 1949. Of these, passenger cars numbered 90,998, while 18,087 were commercial vehicles.

Sales and Financing Compared

Table 9 shows the number of vehicle sales financed as a percentage of total sales for June and for the first six months of 1949 and 1950. This comparison indicates a somewhat higher proportion of sales financed in the current year.

NEW MOTOR VEHICLE SALES


1947—48—49—50

JANUARY TO JUNE


