Sales of New Motor Vehicles

September sales of new motor vehicles showed gains of 38% in number and 46% in value compared with September 1949. The increase was substantial but nevertheless lower than the average rate of increase for the previous eight months of 1950. There were 39,050 new vehicles sold in September 1950 at a retail value of \$82,952,096. In September a year ago, 28,239 new vehicles sold for \$56,656,841.

By far the most outstanding gain was recorded in British Columbia where sales totalled 4,516 vehicles valued at \$8,926,829, an increase of 94% in number and 102% in value over September 1949 when 2,326 vehicles sold for \$4,412,334.

Passenger cars and trucks shared alike in the increase. There were 33,215 new passenger cars with a retail value of \$60,020,515 sold in September this year. Increases over September 1949 amounted to 38% in number and 45% in value. New truck sales registered gains of 39% in number and 42% in value over September last year. Bus sales numbered 78 in September 1950 compared with 12 in September 1949.

In the first nine months of 1950, 329,372 new motor vehicles sold for \$668,983,680, surpassing 1949 number and value for the same period by 54% and 51% respectively. New passenger cars accounted for the major part of these increases, sales of 249,089 units with a retail value of \$500,432,269 being 67% in number and 64% in value higher than the sales in the corresponding period of 1949. Truck sales were up 24% in both number and value. Sales of new buses increased from 443 to 535, or 21%.

FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES

There were 30,178 new and used motor vehicles financed to the extent of \$28,999,935 in September 1950, an increase of 52% in number and 56% in amount of financing over September 1949 when 19,901 vehicles were financed to the extent of \$18,610,478.

New Vehicles--New vehicle sales financed in September 1950 numbered 11,311, an increase of 58% over the September 1949 total of 7,183. The amount of financing was \$16,623,440, 64% above the \$10,129,875 of September a year ago.

In the nine-month period of 1950, 102,903 new vehicles were financed for an amount of \$144,012,716. Increases over last year amounted to 75% in number and 72% in volume of financing. Passenger car financing was mainly responsible for the substantial increases in financing of new motor vehicles. The number of new passenger cars financed increased 101%, while the increase for new commercial vehicles financed amounted to 32%.

Used Vehicles--Substantial increases in the number of used vehicle sales financed were registered for both passenger car and commercial vehicles. Total used vehicle sales financed in September 1950 numbered 18,867, a gain of 48% over September 1949. Passenger cars financed numbered 15,127 units or 48% above September a year ago, while the number of commercial vehicle sales financed rose 61%.



Used vehicle sales financed during the first nine months of 1950 numbered 174,394, a gain of 52% over the corresponding period of 1949, while the amount of financing increased 46%, from \$79,317,744 to \$115,687,680.
