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NEW MOTOR VEHICLES SALES

AND

MOTOR VEHICLE FINANCING

DECEMBER 1951

Sales of new motor vehicles totalled 19,799 units with a retail value of \$50,788,377 in December, 1951, 33% lower in number and 20% lower in value than the 29,328 vehicles which sold for \$63,782,256 in December last year. The drop in sales of passenger cars was solely responsible for this decline; only 12,931 passenger cars valued at \$32,916,820 were sold during this period as against sales of 22,647 valued at \$49,030,353 during the same period a year ago. Sales of commercial vehicles showed slight gains over December 1950 in both number and value, 3% and 21% respectively.

A review of the preliminary results for the year 1951 indicates that the number of new vehicles sold, although in excess of 1950 for the months of January to April, declined for the balance of the year. The cumulative total for the year 1951 was 384,756 units with a retail value of \$946,062,124 as against a total of 429,695 new vehicles sold with a value of \$885,669,039 in 1950. All provinces registered declines over last year. The greatest drop, 23%, occurred in British Columbia.

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**Note:** Retail values quoted in this report are based on the retail price to individual purchasers at the Canadian point of manufacture. In the case of imported vehicles, the values are the retail price delivered at the nearest Canadian distributing centre. Retail values include sales and excise taxes, charges for standard accessories, dealers' commissions, etc. Transportation charges from Canadian point of manufacture to point of delivery are not included.

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The heading "Commercial Vehicles" used in the main tables of this report represents the combined sales of trucks and buses. Sales of buses in December are shown separately in the following table.

Financing of Motor Vehicle Sales

New Vehicles - The number of new vehicle sales financed in December declined 13% from December 1950 while the amount of financing was 4% below that of the same period last year. During 1951, there were 126,034 new vehicles financed for a value of \$190,928,186 as compared with 135,304 units with a financed value of \$191,434,712 during 1950. As in the case of new vehicle sales, passenger cars accounted for this decline. Financing of commercial vehicles showed increases of 16% and 34% respectively in number of units financed and amount of financing during 1951.

Used Vehicles - Both the number of used vehicles financed and the amount of financing were greater in December 1951 than in the same month of 1950, in both the passenger car and commercial classes. The most outstanding gains occurred in Saskatchewan which registered an increase of 60% in number of used vehicles financed and a 75% increase in amount of financing during December 1951 as compared to the same period last year. On the other hand the Atlantic Provinces showed slight declines from December 1950 both in number and amount of financing, 5% and 3% respectively.


The year's total reveals a 30% increase over 1950 in the number of used vehicles financed and a gain of 23% in the amount of financing.

### % CHANGE IN NEW MOTOR VEHICLE SALES BY PROVINCES 1951/1950


